State accredited curriculum and a recognised qualification providing skills to gain work in the many sectors of the equine industry.

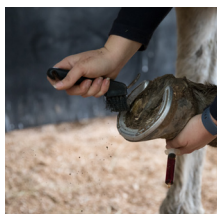

Course duration is over 2 years as part of a VET delivered to secondary students program and may be used as a VCE VM or VCE subject.

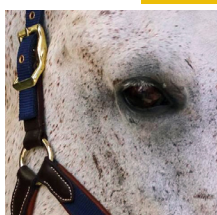
